SUBMISSION OF PAPERS TO THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE YORKSHIRE GEOLOGICAL SOCIETY

We are working with the Geological Society of London Publishing House (GSPH) towards online submission of papers to the *Proceedings of the Yorkshire Geological Society* (PYGS) using Editorial Manager®.

In the meantime, authors should email their submissions to Jessica Pollitt (jessica.pollitt@geolsoc.org.uk), PYGS Production Editor at the GSPH. Text, tables and figure captions should be submitted as Word files, with figures and plates as either PDFs or low-resolution native files. If your paper is accepted, the final submission will be expected to include the high-resolution native files for figures and plates (e.g. EPS or TIF files). Editorial correspondence should be sent to the Journal Editor (see inside front cover).
